## Ascension Day

Thursday May 21st 2020

Welcome to Holy Innocents on the Feast of the Ascension.

Today, we keep this short morning devotion of music and prayer.

Then we invite all our congregation who would have attended church this evening to listen to the Eucharist for Ascension Day on BBC Radio 4 at 8pm.

Members of our choir may have contributed to the singing this evening.

"I will not leave you comfortless."

The Ascensiontide narrative from the Acts of the Apostles tells of Christ's 'withdrawing' from his disciples, leaving them, as he ascends to the Father in glory.

From now, until Pentecost, we have a time of prayer and reflection, the time when we are – with those first disciples – waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Each week, members of our church community share their thoughts and prayers through a social media group. One such thought (made as people across the world try to work out how best to respond to the changes that have happened as a result of Covid-19 and which have touched almost every life) called on us all to let hope make us take one more step than fear. The French hymn writers Michel Scouarnec and Jo Akepsimas used this idea as the first line of a powerful song, which reflects on the many ways that human weakness can turn to strength and overcome the trials and tests of this world.

Sung in the original French, the words are shown in English and Farsi as well.

## The choir sings:

Hail the day that sees him rise Alleluia! To his throne beyond the skies; Alleluia! Christ, the Lamb for sinners giv'n, Alleluia! Enters now the highest heav'n! Alleluia!

There for him high triumph waits: Alleluia! Lift your heads, eternal gates; Alleluia! He has conquered death and sin; Alleluia! Take the King of glory in. Alleluia!

Lord, though parted from our sight, Alleluia! Far beyond the starry height, Alleluia! Lift our hearts that we may rise Alleluia! One with you beyond the skies: Alleluia!

There we shall with thee remain, Alleluia! Partners of thine endless reign, Alleluia! There thy face unclouded see, Alleluia! Find our heav'n of heav'ns in thee. Alleluia!

The collect for Ascension Day is said:
Grant, we pray, almighty God,
that as we believe your only-begotten
Son our Lord Jesus Christ
to have ascended into the heavens,
so we in heart and mind
may also ascend
and with him continually dwell;
who is alive and reigns with you,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever.

The Ascension Narrative from the beginning of the Acts of the Apostles is read:

In the first book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus did and taught from the beginning until the day when he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. After his suffering he presented himself alive to them by many convincing proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While staying with them, he ordered them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for the promise of the Father. "This," he said, "is what you have heard from me: for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." So when they had come together. they asked him, "Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?" He replied, "It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." When he had said this, as they were watching, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight.

، یعقوب (پسر حلفی)، شمعون (که به او غیور میگفتند)، یهودا (پسر یعقوب)، و برادران عیسی. چند زن از جمله مادر عیسی نیز در آنجا حضور داشتند. او در مدت چهل روز پس از مرگ خود، بار ها خود را زنده به رسولان ظاهر ساخت و به طرق گوناگون به ایشان ثابت کرد که و اقعاً زنده شده است. در این فرصتها، او درباره و ملکوت خدا با ایشان سخن میگفت

در یکی از این دیدار ها بود که عیسی به ایشان گفت: "از شهر اورشلیم بیرون نروید بلکه منتظر روحالقدس باشید زیرا او همان هدیهای است که پدرم و عدهاش را داده و من نیز در بارهاش با شما سخن گفتم. "یحیی شما را با آب تعمید داد ولی تا چند روز دیگر شما با روحالقدس تعمید خواهید یافت."

هنگامی که عیسی با شاگردان بود آنان از او پرسیدند: "خداوندا، آیا در همین زمان است که حکومت از دست رفته، اسرائیل را باز برقرار خواهی کرد؟" جواب داد: "این زمانها را پدرم خدا تعیین میکند و دانستن آنها کار شما نیست. ولی آنچه لازم است بدانید این است که خواهید یافت تا در "اورشلیم"، در سراسر "یهودیه"، "سامره"، و تا دورترین نقطه ء دنیا درباره ء من شهادت دهید."

پس از آنکه عیسی این سخنان را به پایان رساند، در مقابل چشمان ایشان، بسوی آسمان بالا رفت و در ابری ناپدید گشت. While he was going and they were gazing up toward heaven, suddenly two men in white robes stood by them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."
