### **ENTRANCE HYMN 205**

The president and preacher today is the Revd Jane Walker. Please remain standing for the greeting and act of penitence.

+ In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

As we prepare to celebrate the presence of Christ in word and sacrament, let us call to mind our sins and confess them in penitence and faith.

A time of silent prayer follows, then: Most merciful God,

we confess that we have sinned in thought, word and deed.

We have not loved you with our whole heart.
We have not loved our neighbours as ourselves.

In your mercy forgive what we have been, help us to amend what we are, and direct what we shall be; that we may do justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with you, our God.

May almighty God forgive us our sins, heal and strengthen us by his Spirit, and raise us to new life in Christ our Lord.

Amen.

Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on earth. Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father, we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory. Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father, Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us; you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

**THE COLLECT** The prayer for this Sunday

After a moment of silent prayer, the president says the Collect.

At the end: Amen.

Please sit down for the Ministry of the Word.

FIRST READING Habbakuk 2: 1-4

At the end:

This is the word of the Lord.

Thanks be to God.

# PSALM 31. 1-6 Please remain seated and join in the refrain, based on a Ukrainian Kyrie.

Lord, you have redeemed me, Lord, you are my refuge, Keep my soul in safety, Lord my God.

Hear my voice when I call on you for help; preserve me from shame; Deliver me from danger; come quickly to my aid.

You are my rock, my stronghold and my guide; keep me safe from harm; Free me from the snare -from the trap laid to catch me.

# SECOND READING Ephesians 2: 9-end

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling-place for God.

At the end:

Praise to you, O Christ.

Please sit down for the sermon. After the sermon there will be a time of silence. Then all please STAND with the president for the Creed.

We believe in God the Father,

from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named.

We believe in God the Son, who lives in our hearts through faith,

and fills us with his love.

We believe in God the Holy Spirit, who strengthens us with power from on high. We believe in one God:

Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.

Please remain standing for the Prayer of the Faithful. After each section a cantor sings:

Lord of life, we turn to you

All join in:

Lord of all, our saviour be, come to heal and to bless, with the power of your love.

After the final section (for the departed) there will be a time of silent prayer. At the end:

Merciful Father,

accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ, Amen

The president introduces THE PEACE:
We are the Body of Christ. In the one Spirit

we were all baptized into one body. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life.

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

And also with you.

The president introduces THE PEACE:

Christ is our peace; he has reconciled us to God in one body by the cross. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life.

The peace of the Lord be always with you. **And also with you.** 

All exchange a sign of peace.

# **OFFERTORY HYMN 294**

The bread and wine are brought to the altar. The president says a prayer over the gifts to which we all respond:

Blessed be God for ever.

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER follows.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

The president continues the prayer, thanking God for his saving works, and then invites the people to join their praises with the whole company of heaven:

.....for ever praising you and singing:

Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he

who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

Christ has died: Christ is risen: Christ will come again.

The president continues the prayer. At the end of the prayer the president says:

....all honour and glory be yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever:

Amen.

The president introduces the Lord's Prayer and all say together:

Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be your name;
your kingdom come,
your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us today our daily bread;
Forgive us our sins,
as we forgive those who sin against us.
Let not enter into temptation
but deliver us from evil.

For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours, now and for ever. Amen.

We SIT or KNEEL as the president breaks the consecrated bread in pieces for all to share:

We break this bread

to share in the body of Christ.

Though we are many we are one body, because we all share in one bread.

Jesus, Lamb of God: have mercy on us. Jesus, bearer of our sins: have mercy on us. Jesus, redeemer of the world: give us your peace. The president addresses those who wish to come to Holy Communion:

Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world; blessed are those who are called to his supper.

Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed.

Those who wish to receive Holy Communion approach the altar. Communicant members of other churches are invited to receive Holy Communion with us. During communion, we hear Lead me Lord (Wesley) and then please join in the Taizé chants shown. When all have received holy communion what remains of the consecrated bread will be placed in the tabernacle for the communion of those at home. At the end of the silence all please STAND with the President.

Let us pray.

Silent prayer.

God of our pilgrimage,
you have led us to the living water:
refresh and sustain us
as we go forward on our journey,
in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
Please join in:
