This leaflet contains all you need to join in the service. Words **in bold print** are spoken or sung by all. Hymns are not announced. For visitors, Gift Aid envelopes are available for donations. Please be as still and quiet as possible before the service as we prepare to celebrate the Eucharist.

When the bell rings, please stand to join in:

ENTRANCE HYMN 146

The president today is the Revd Janina Ainsworth.. Please remain standing for the greeting and act of penitence.

+ In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

God knows the innermost thoughts of our hearts. In sorrow for our sin, we turn to him for mercy and for grace.

A time of silent prayer follows, then: God be gracious to us and bless us, and make your face shine upon us: Lord, have mercy. Lord, have mercy. May your ways be known on the earth, your saving power among the nations: Christ, have mercy.

Christ, have mercy.

You, Lord, have made known your salvation, and reveal your justice in the sight of the nations: Lord, have mercy.

Lord, have mercy.

May God forgive us our sins, heal and strengthen us by his Spirit, and raise us to new life in Christ our Lord.

Amen.

Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on earth. Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father, we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory. Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father, Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us; you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

THE COLLECT The prayer for this Sunday

After a moment of silent prayer the president says the Collect.

At the end: Amen.

Please sit down for the Ministry of the Word.

FIRST READING Isaiah 40.12-17, 27-end

At the end:

This is the word of the Lord.

Thanks be to God.

Please stand for the Gospel Acclamation

GOSPEL READING Matthew 28.16-end

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew.

Glory to you, O Lord.

and Trinity in unity.

At the end: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

Praise to you, O Christ.

Please sit down for the sermon. The preacher today is the Revd Richard Young. After the sermon there will be a time of silence. Then all please STAND with the president for the Creed.

Let us declare our faith and the faith of the Church: We worship one God in Trinity.

Neither confounding the persons, nor dividing the substance.

For there is one person of the Father, another of the Son,

and another of the Holy Spirit.

The Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, is all one, the glory equal, the majesty co-eternal.

Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Spirit:

uncreated, eternal and beyond our understanding, not three but one, equal in might.

And in this Trinity none is afore, or after another;

none is greater or less than another; **But the whole three persons**

are co-eternal together and co-equal, to be worshipped by the faithful, now and for ever. Amen.

Please remain standing for the Prayer of the Faithful. After each section:

Lord, in your mercy:

hear our prayer.

After the final section (for the departed) there will be a time of silent prayer.

At the end:

Merciful Father,

accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ, Amen

The president introduces THE PEACE:

We are the Body of Christ.

In the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life. The peace of the Lord be always with you.

And also with you.

All exchange a sign of peace and then join in:

OFFERTORY HYMN 373

The bread and wine are brought to the altar. The president says a prayer over the gifts to which we all respond:

Blessed be God for ever.

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER follows.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

THE PRESIDENT continues the prayer, thanking God for his saving works, and then invites the people to join their praises with the whole company of heaven:

.....for ever praising you and singing:

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who

comes in the name of the Lord.

Hosanna in the highest.

THE PRESIDENT asks the Father to send the Holy Spirit to sanctify the bread and wine, and then repeats the Lord's own words over the bread and cup.....

Great is the mystery of faith:

Christ has died: Christ is risen: Christ will come again.

THE PRESIDENT CONTINUES, joining our offering with Christ's sacrifice of himself. At the end of the prayer the president says:

.....all honour and glory be yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever: Amen.

The President introduces the Lord's Prayer and all say together:

Our Father in heaven. hallowed be your name; your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Do not let us enter into temptation but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours, now and for ever. Amen.

We SIT or KNEEL as the president breaks the consecrated bread in pieces for all to share: We break this bread to share in the body of Christ. Though we are many we are one body, because we all share in one bread.

The president addresses those who wish to come to Holy Communion:

Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world; blessed are those who are called to his supper.

Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed.

Those who wish to receive Holy Communion or a blessing draw near to the altar. Receiving from the chalice remains optional. During communion we sing some verses from Hymns 159 and 278.

When all have received holy communion what remains of the consecrated bread will be placed in the tabernacle and there will be a time of stillness and quiet. Then all please STAND with the President.
