NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

We wish to install two security lights to the exterior of the church, facing the church car park. A quotation for the work detailing what is proposed has been uploaded as part of our online faculty entry. We have also uploaded a photograph of the northern side of the church with the proposed locations of the two lights marked in red.

The lights would be fixed to the exterior wall of the side aisle as indicated on the attached photograph. Fixings would be by four screws and rawplugs for each light. The lights would be at the top of this wall, c.15 feet above ground level and so out of reach in terms of the risk of tampering.

The location is also chosen because at the corresponding height on the inside of the wall there is an existing channel in which cables already run: this would enable a single drilled hole through the wall and wiring inside otherwise to be invisible. The two locations are sited so as to shed light over the church car park and also the path commonly taken by pedestrians through the adjoining car park and out into Landcross Road.

Removal of the lights would leave minor damage to the face of the building which could readily be restored to its original state by means of replacement of a small number of bricks externally and minor plastering on the inside.

Our electrical contractor has proposed lights which would come on automatically at dusk and then switch off at a fixed time which could be adjusted from a control panel in the church (this would be sited alongside the existing banks of switches in the church North Side Lobby).

### **Directions to petitioner**

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
