Please be as still and quiet as possible before the service as we prepare together to celebrate the Eucharist. When the bell rings, please stand. The president today is the Revd Jane Walker. Please remain standing for the greeting and act of penitence.

Amen.

All are invited to call to mind their sin.
God knows the innermost thoughts of our hearts. In sorrow for our sin, we turn to him for mercy and for grace.

A time of silent prayer follows, then:

*God be gracious to us and bless us,
and make your face shine upon us:
Lord, have mercy.*

*May your ways be known on the earth,
your saving power among the nations:
Christ, have mercy.*

*You, Lord, have made known your salvation,
and reveal your justice in the sight of the

strengthen us by his Spirit, and raise us to
new life in Christ our Lord. Amen.*

and peace to his people on earth.**

**Lord God, heavenly King,
almighty God and Father,**

**we worship you, we give you thanks,
we praise you for your glory.**

**Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father,
Lord God, Lamb of God,**

**you take away the sin of the world:
have mercy on us;**

**you are seated at the right hand of the
Father: receive our prayer.**

**For you alone are the Holy One,
you alone are the Lord,**

**you alone are the Most High,
Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit,
in the glory of God the Father. Amen.**

THE COLLECT The prayer for this Sunday

Let us pray.

After a moment of silent prayer the president says the Collect. At the end: **Amen.**

Please sit down for the Ministry of the Word.

FIRST READING Isaiah 6.1-8

At the end:

This is the word of the Lord.

Thanks be to God.

PSALM 29

All on earth and all in heaven

Raise to God a song on high;

Strength unmeasured, love unbounded -

God alone we glorify.

Holiness and beauty blending

Hear God's voice across the earth

Speaking to the mighty waters

Sound and light: new life, new birth.

*Trees shall bow in awe and wonder –
Bend their branches to the ground;
From God's lips one word in anger
wreaks destruction all around.
But the Word which set in motion
such travails can make them cease;
that same voice which tumult beckons -
in a gentler breath speaks peace.*

SECOND READING Romans 8.12-17

So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh-- for if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received a spirit of adoption. When we cry, "Abba! Father!" it is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ--if, in fact, we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him.

This is the word of the Lord.

Please stand for the Gospel Acclamation.

GOSPEL READING John 3.1-17

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John.

Glorify to you, O Lord.

At the end:

This is the Gospel of the Lord.

Praise to you, O Christ.

Please sit down for the sermon. The preacher today is the Revd Canon Alma Servant. After the sermon there will be a time of silence. Then please stand with the president for the Profession of Faith (taken from the Athanasian Creed):

Let us declare our faith and the faith of the Church: we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in unity.

Neither confounding the persons, nor dividing the substance.

For there is one person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Spirit.

The Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, is all one, the glory equal, the majesty co-eternal.

Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Spirit:

uncreated, eternal and

beyond our understanding.

not three but one, equal in might.

And in this Trinity

none is afore, or after another;

none is greater or less than another;

But the whole three persons are co-eternal together and co-equal, to be worshipped by the faithful, now and for ever. Amen.

Please remain standing for the Prayer of the Faithful. After each section:

Lord, in your mercy:

hear our prayer.

After the final section (for the departed) there will be a time of silent prayer. At the end:

Merciful Father,

accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen

The president introduces THE PEACE:

We are the Body of Christ. In the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life.

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

And also with you.

All exchange a sign of peace as we hear:

Holy, holy, holy! Lord God Almighty!

Early in the morning

our song shall rise to Thee;

Holy, holy, holy, merciful and mighty!

God in three Persons, blessed Trinity!

Holy, holy, holy! All the saints adore Thee,

Casting down their golden crowns

around the glassy sea,

Cherubim and seraphim

falling down before Thee,

Who wert and art, and evermore shalt be.

Holy, holy, holy!

Though the darkness hide Thee,

Though the sinful human eye

Thy glory may not see;

Only Thou art holy; there is none beside Thee,

Perfect in power, love, and purity.

Holy, holy, holy! Lord God Almighty!

All Thy works shall praise Thy name

in earth and sky and sea;

Holy, holy, holy, merciful and mighty!

God in three Persons, blessed Trinity!

The offerings of the people are collected and the bread and wine are brought to the altar.

The president says a prayer over the gifts to which we all respond:

Blessed be God for ever.

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER follows.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

THE PRESIDENT continues the prayer, thanking God for his saving works, and then invites the people to join their praises with the whole company of heaven:

.....for ever praising you and singing:

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and

might, heaven and earth are full of your

glory. Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the

Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

THE PRESIDENT asks the Father to send the Holy Spirit to sanctify the bread and wine, and then repeats the Lord's own words over the bread and cup.....*Great is the mystery of faith:*

Christ has died: Christ is risen:

Christ will come again.

THE PRESIDENT CONTINUES, joining our offering with Christ's sacrifice of himself. At the end of the prayer the president says:

.....all honour and glory be yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever: Amen.

The President introduces the Lord's Prayer and all say together:

Our Father, who art in heaven

hallowed be thy name;

thy kingdom come,

thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread

And forgive us our trespasses,

as we forgive those who trespass against us.

And lead us not into temptation

but deliver us from evil;

for thine is the kingdom, the power

and the glory for ever and ever. Amen.

We SIT or KNEEL as the president breaks the consecrated bread in pieces for all to share:

We break this bread

to share in the body of Christ.

Though we are many we are one body,

because we all share in one bread.

Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world, have mercy on us.

The president addresses those who wish to come to Holy Communion:

Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world; blessed are those who are called to his supper.

Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,

but only say the word and I shall be healed.

Those who wish to receive Holy Communion or a blessing draw near to the altar.

During communion we hear *Christ be with me and Father of Heaven whose love profound.*

When all have received Holy Communion what remains of the consecrated bread will be placed in the tabernacle as we hear:

How shall I sing that majesty which angels do admire?

Let dust in dust and silence lie

- sing, sing, ye heavenly choir.

Thousands of thousands stand around

thy throne, O God most high;

Ten thousand times ten thousand sound

thy praise; but who am I?

Thy brightness unto them appears,

while I Thy footsteps trace;

A sound of God comes to my ears,

but they behold Thy face.

I shall, I fear, be dark and cold,

with all my fire and light;

Yet when Thou dost accept their gold,

Lord, treasure up my mite.

Enlighten with faith's light my heart,

in flame it with love's fire;

Then shall I sing and take my part

with that celestial choir.

They sing because Thou art their Sun;

Lord, send a beam on me;

For where heaven is but once begun,

there alleluias be.

How great a being, Lord, is Thine,

which doth all beings keep!

Thy knowledge is the only line

to sound so vast a deep.

Thou art a sea without a shore,

a sun without a sphere;

Thy time is now and evermore,

thy place is everywhere.

After a time of silence please stand with the President.

Let us pray.

After a moment of silent prayer:

Almighty and eternal God, you have revealed yourself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and live and reign in the perfect unity of love:

hold us firm in this faith,

that we may know you in all your ways

and evermore rejoice in your eternal glory,

who are three Persons yet one God,

now and for ever. Amen.

PLEASE SIT for the announcements then STAND for the blessing and dismissal.

The God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, and the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son + and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always.

Amen.

Go in the peace of Christ:
