Let us reflect together on the times when we have not reflected the love of God as revealed in Jesus to each other or the world, and seek God's forgiveness:

*A time of silent prayer follows, then:*

God be gracious to us and bless us, and make your face shine upon us:

Lord, have mercy. **Lord, have mercy.**

May your ways be known on the earth:

your saving power among the nations:

Christ, have mercy. **Christ, have mercy.**

You, Lord, have made known your salvation, and reveal your justice in the sight of the nations: Lord, have mercy. **Lord, have mercy.**

May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life.

**Amen.**

**Glory to God in the highest,**

**and peace to his people on earth.**

**Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father, we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory.**

The nations shall see your vindication, and all the kings your glory; and you shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the LORD will give. You shall be a crown of beauty in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God.

You shall no more be termed Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate; for as a young man marries a young woman, so shall your builder marry you, and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

*At the end:*

This is the word of the Lord.

*At the end:* This is the Gospel of the Lord.

**Praise to you, O Christ.**

*Please sit down for the sermon. The preacher today is the Revd Canon Michael Ainsworth.*

*After the sermon there will be a time of silence.*

*Then all stand with the president for the Creed:*

We believe in one God,

**the Father, the Almighty,**

**maker of heaven and earth,**

**of all that is, seen and unseen.**

**We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ,**

**the only Son of God,**

**eternally begotten of the Father,**

**God from God, Light from Light,**

**true God from true God,**

**begotten, not made,**

**of one Being with the Father;**

**through him all things were made.**

**For us and for our salvation**

**he came down from heaven,**

**was incarnate from the Holy Spirit**

**and the Virgin Mary and was made man.**

**For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried.**

**On the third day he rose again**

**in accordance with the Scriptures;**

**he ascended into heaven and is seated**

**at the right hand of the Father.**

**He will come again in glory**

**to judge the living and the dead,**

**and his kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the Lord, the giver of life,  
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,  
who with the Father and the Son  
is worshipped and glorified,  
who has spoken through the prophets.  
We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic  
Church. We acknowledge one baptism  
for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the  
resurrection of the dead, and the life of the  
world to come. Amen.**

*Please remain standing for the Prayer of the  
Faithful. After each section:*

Lord, in your mercy

**hear our prayer.**

*After the final section (for the departed) there will  
be a time of silent prayer.*

*At the end:*

Merciful Father,

**Accept these prayers,  
for the sake of your Son,  
our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.**

*The president introduces THE PEACE:*

Our Saviour Christ is the Prince of Peace.

Of the increase of his government and of  
peace there shall be no end.

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

**And also with you.**

*All exchange a sign of peace.*

## **OFFERTORY HYMN 56**

*The offerings of the people are collected and the  
bread and wine are brought to the altar. The  
president says a prayer over the gifts to which we  
all respond:*

**Blessed be God for ever.**

*THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER follows.*

The Lord be with you.

**And also with you.**

Lift up your hearts.

**We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**It is right to give thanks and praise.**

*The president continues the prayer, thanking God  
for his saving works, and then invites the people  
to join their praises with the whole company of  
heaven:*

.....and sing our joyful hymn of praise:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and  
might, heaven and earth are full of your  
glory. Hosanna in the highest.  
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the  
Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

*The president asks the Father to send the Holy  
Spirit to sanctify the bread and wine, and then  
repeats the Lord's own words over the bread and  
cup. ....*

Great is the mystery of faith:

**Christ has died: Christ is risen:**

**Christ will come again.**

*The president continues, joining our offering with  
Christ's sacrifice of himself.*

*At the end of the prayer the president says:*

....we worship you, Father almighty, in songs  
of everlasting praise:

**Blessing and honour and glory and power  
be yours for ever and ever. Amen.**

*The President introduces the Lord's Prayer and all  
say together:*

**Our Father in heaven,  
hallowed be your name,  
your kingdom come,  
may your will be done on earth  
as it is in heaven.**

**Give us today our daily bread**

**and forgive us our sins**

**as we forgive those who sin against us.**

**Do not let us enter into temptation,**

**but deliver us from evil,**

**for the kingdom, the power and the glory**

**are yours for ever and ever. Amen.**

*Those who wish draw near to the altar. Those who are baptized are invited to receive Holy Communion.*

*Others are asked to fold their arms for a blessing.*

*During communion, please join in Christ is our light and Hymn 431. When all have received Holy Communion there is a time of stillness and quiet then all please stand with the President.*

Let us pray.

*After a moment of silent prayer:*

Almighty God, accept our praise and thanksgiving for what already unites us.

**Hasten the hour when we will recognise each other in the one communion you willed and for which your son prayed to you in the power of the Spirit. Amen.**
