What would this look like if we did Lenten discipline as a church? What would we give up and what would we take up, not necessarily forever but for a few weeks? And how might this change us?

If you have any ideas, please let me know! And whether you're comfortable with 'Happy' or not, have a blessed, holy and joyful Lent."

## ***This month's guest slot: a view from St. Paul's, Withington***

"I'm Cate Allison, Assistant Curate at both St Paul's, Withington and St James and Emmanuel. I was only licensed last September so I'm still very new. I'm absolutely loving my current roles. A friend recently asked if I felt I was continuing to become more of the person God has called to be and I was definitely able to say yes.

One great joy of working across two churches and a number of congregations is the range of worship I have the privilege to lead and participate in. Sunday can begin with BCP worship at St James followed by a sung Eucharist at St Paul's and end with the relaxed informality of the 6.15 service at Emmanuel.

For the last few months my main focus has been on St Paul's. It's been great to support the congregation in getting things going again and re-establishing links with the local community. In addition to our Sunday morning Sung Eucharist supported by our amazing choir we have a monthly Bible and Butties service at 5pm with our friends from L'Arche and a monthly service of Choral evensong led by our excellent Reader Tom Hennell. There's lots more going on as well and we've just achieved our Bronze Eco Church award.

Before ordination I had a career leading and managing services in the voluntary sector and in local government. My last role was as CEO of Manchester Action on Street Health, a charity supporting sex workers and other marginalised and vulnerable women. I'm finding myself able to bring the experience gained to my current role, whether working in partnership with the foodbank to develop a new project or as a trustee of the Church Urban Fund.

Partnership and collaborative working have always been important to me so it's great to be part of the Mission Community, particularly one that builds on existing strong relationships and a shared commitment to inclusion.
