

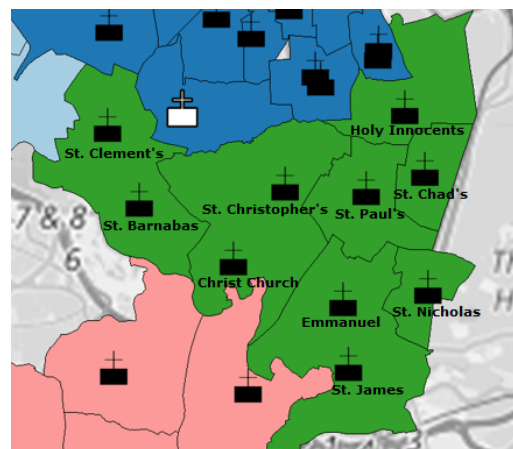

We are starting September with our very popular annual Pride Celebration in the grounds of Emmanuel Church, from midday on Saturday 3rd September, behind the Library in Didsbury Village. All are welcome – do come to the Church stall and say hello!

Later (from 7pm on eight successive Tuesdays from September 20th) we are providing an eight-week course called 'Deep Waters' (by the Green Christian organisation) to help people address the feelings of anxiety about climate change that are becoming known as 'climate grief'.
