*The president today is the Revd Jane Walker.  
Please remain standing for the greeting and act of  
penitence.*

+ In the name of the Father, and of the Son  
and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

**And also with you.**

God knows the innermost thoughts of our  
hearts. In sorrow for our sin, we turn to him  
for mercy and for grace.

*A time of silent prayer follows, then:*

God be gracious to us and bless us,  
and make your face shine upon us:  
Lord, have mercy: **Lord, have mercy.**

May your ways be known on the earth,  
your saving power among the nations:  
Christ, have mercy. **Christ, have mercy.**

You, Lord, have made known your salvation,  
and reveal your justice in the sight of the  
nations: Lord, have mercy.

**Lord, have mercy.**

May God forgive us our sins, heal and  
strengthen us by his Spirit, and raise us to  
new life in Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

**Glory to God in the highest, and peace to  
his people on earth. Lord God, heavenly  
King, almighty God and Father,  
we worship you, we give you thanks,  
we praise you for your glory.  
Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father,  
Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the  
sin of the world: have mercy on us;  
you are seated at the right hand of the  
Father: receive our prayer.  
For you alone are the Holy One, you alone  
are the Lord, you alone are the Most High,  
Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit,  
in the glory of God the Father. Amen.**

**THE COLLECT** The prayer for this Sunday

Let us pray.

*After a moment of silent prayer the president says  
the Collect. At the end: Amen.*

*Please sit down for the Ministry of the Word.*

**FIRST READING** Deuteronomy 4.1-2, 6-9

So now, Israel, give heed to the laws and rules that I am teaching you, so that you may live to enter and occupy the land that the LORD is giving you. You must neither add anything to what I command you nor take away anything from it, but keep the laws of the LORD your God with which I am charging you. You must observe them diligently, for this will show your wisdom and discernment to the peoples, who, when they hear all these statutes, will say, "Surely this great nation is a wise and discerning people!" For what other great nation has a god so near to it as the LORD our God is whenever we call to him?

And what other great nation has laws and rules as just as this entire law that I am setting before you today? But take care and watch yourselves closely, so as neither to forget the things that your eyes have seen nor to let them slip from your mind all the days of your life; make them known to your children and your children's children.

*At the end:* This is the word of the Lord.

*Please stand to join in the Gospel Acclamation:*

Every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above, coming down from the Father, with whom there is no shadow of change. **Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.**

**GOSPEL READING** Mark 7.1-8,14,15, 21-23

The Lord be with you:

**And also with you.**

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Mark.

**Glory to you, O Lord.**

*At the end:* This is the Gospel of the Lord.

**Praise to you, O Christ.**

*Please sit down for the sermon. The preacher today is the Revd Richard Young. After the sermon here will be a time of silence. Then all please stand for the Creed:*

We believe in God the Father,  
**rom whom every family  
n heaven and on earth is named.**

We believe in God the Son,  
**who lives in our hearts through faith,  
and fills us with his love.**

We believe in God the Holy Spirit,  
**who strengthens us  
with power from on high.**

We believe in one God;  
**Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.**

*Please remain standing for the Prayer of the Faithful. After each section:*

Lord, in your mercy:

**hear our prayer.**

*After the final section (for the departed) there will be a time of silent prayer.*

At the end:

Merciful Father,  
**accept these prayers for the sake of your  
Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen**

*The president introduces THE PEACE:*

God is love and those who live in love live in  
God and God lives in them. The peace of the  
Lord be always with you.

**And also with you.**

*All exchange a sign of peace, then please join in:*

### **HYMN 55**

*The bread and wine are brought to the altar.*

*The president says a prayer over the gifts to which  
we all respond:*

**Blessed be God for ever.**

*THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER follows.*

The Lord be with you.

**And also with you.**

Lift up your hearts.

**We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**It is right to give thanks and praise.**

*THE PRESIDENT continues the prayer, thanking  
God for his saving works, and then invites the  
people to join their praises with the whole  
company of heaven:*

.....their unending song of praise:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,  
God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.**

**Blessed is he who comes in the name  
of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

*THE PRESIDENT asks the Father to send the Holy  
Spirit to sanctify the bread and wine, and then  
repeats the Lord's own words over the bread and  
cup. ....Great is the mystery of faith:*

**Christ has died: Christ is risen:**

**Christ will come again.**

*THE PRESIDENT CONTINUES, joining our offering  
with Christ's sacrifice of himself. At the end of the  
prayer the president says:*

.....all honour and glory be yours, almighty  
Father, for ever and ever: **Amen.**

*The President introduces the Lord's Prayer and we  
all say together:*

**Our Father who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy name;  
thy kingdom come, thy will be done on  
earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread  
and forgive us our trespasses,  
as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
And lead us not into temptation  
but deliver us from evil;  
for thine is the kingdom, the power  
and the glory for ever and ever. Amen.**

consecrated bread in pieces for all to share:*

**Though we are many we are one body,  
because we all share in one bread.**

**Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the  
world, have mercy on us.**

*The president addresses those who wish to come  
to Holy Communion:*

Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the  
sins of the world; blessed are those  
who are called to his supper.

**Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,  
but only say the word and I shall be healed.**

*Those who wish to receive Holy Communion or a  
blessing approach the altar. During communion  
please join in the hymn shown on the back of this  
leaflet. When all have received Holy Communion  
what remains of the consecrated bread will be  
placed in the tabernacle and then, after a time of  
stillness please STAND with the President.*

Let us pray.

*(After a moment of silent prayer)*

Lord God, the source of truth and love,  
keep us faithful to the apostles'  
teaching and fellowship,  
**united in prayer and the breaking of bread,  
and one in joy and simplicity of heart,  
in Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

*Please join in:*

**You are salt for the earth, O people:  
salt for the kingdom of God.**

**Share the flavour of life, O people:  
life in the kingdom of God.**

***Bring forth the kingdom of mercy,  
Bring forth the kingdom of peace;  
Bring forth the kingdom of justice,  
Bring forth the city of God.***

**You are a light on the hill, O people:  
light for the city of God!**

**Shine so holy and bright, O people:  
shine for the kingdom of God.**

**You are a seed of the Word, O people:  
Bring forth the kingdom of God;  
Seeds of mercy and seeds of justice,  
Grow in the kingdom of God.**

**We are a blest and a pilgrim people:  
bound for the kingdom of God.  
Love our journey and love our homeland:  
Love is the kingdom of God!**

*PLEASE SIT for the announcements then STAND for  
the blessing and dismissal.*

Go forth into the world in peace;  
be of good courage; hold fast to that which is  
good; render to no one evil for evil;  
strengthen the fainthearted;  
support the weak; help the afflicted;  
honour everyone; love and serve the Lord,  
rejoicing in the power of the Holy Spirit;  
and the blessing of God almighty, the Father,  
the Son + and the Holy Spirit,  
be among you and remain with you always.  
**Amen.**
